



My Dashboard

Once you are logged-in, you will be on your Dashboard.

1. If you already have an eForm created, scroll down until you see the “eForm” hyperlink.
2. If you do not have an eForm created, click on the **Blue**, “Initialize Preseparation Counseling” link.
3. Complete the eForm to the best of your ability and then **“Save”** the form. Once saved, the form will identify any item needing your attention, ensure you input into the areas that require your input.
4. Once all mandatory items are on the form, save again, and then you can go to the signature page and click, the **Blue** “click here to sign and lock” link.
5. Once your e-signature is on the eForm you can close and log-out.



The DD-2586 contains detailed descriptions and civilian equivalent job skills and training that Service members acquired while in the military. The cover letter is intended to provide the service member with additional information about the VMET document, to include their Service specific information.
