ABOUT JOINT BASE CHARLESTON

MISSION

The 437th and 315th Airlift Wings provide rapid global mobility using the largest fleet of the C-17 Globemaster III. They bring armored vehicles, medical efforts, paratroopers and cargo where it's needed.

The 628th Air Base Wing and the Naval Support Activity provide installation support services to over 60 mission partners and 90K service members, retirees, and families. Approximately 20% of all jobs in the Charleston Metropolitan area are tied to Joint Base Charleston. Joint Base Charleston contributes \$11.1 billion annually to the local economy.

The Navy Nuclear Power Training Command, (NNPTC), trains Navy officers and enlisted in the science and engineering of the design, operations, and maintenance of the naval nuclear propulsion plants. More than 3K sailors graduate and continue to the Nuclear Power Training Unit, (NPTU). At NPTU, students receive hands on training with two moored nuclear training submarines. These students will go on to execute the DoD's no-fail nuclear mission.

Joint Base Charleston is a hub for the storage, maintenance, and export of military supplies and armored vehicles. Military cargo is loaded aboard Navy pre-positioning ships and supplied around the world.

The Naval Health Clinic provides health care services to 12K enrollees and 5K naval nuclear students.

Naval Information Warfare Center (NIWC) creates innovative solutions for the modern-day warfighter. Some of these solutions include satellite systems, undersea surveillance, and remote sensors.

Additionally, the Coast Guard partners with Joint Base Charleston units on river security and law enforcement operations.

HISTORY

Air Force

The first flight took off from Charleston Army Air Field in 1931. The Air Force officially named its facility Charleston Air Force Base in June 1953. For a thorough history of the installation, visit the installation's homepage.

Navy

Commissioned in 1941, Naval Weapons Station (NWS) Charleston had two distinct missions: as the home for two strategic submarine squadrons and a tender, and as an ordnance station with a capacity for more than 60 million pounds of conventional ordnance. The ordnance mission continues today, and Joint Base Charleston - Weapon Station is the only military installation in the continental U.S.

with completely unencumbered explosive safety arcs. The Weapons Station has expanded its mission and DoD support role, and today is a training center for the <u>Naval Nuclear Power Training</u> <u>Command</u>, <u>Nuclear Power Training Unit.</u> and other tenants. LOCATION

Joint Base Charleston (Air Base) is located about 10 miles from downtown Charleston, South Carolina, on approximately 3,400 acres of land within the North Charleston city limits in Charleston County. Joint Base Charleston (Weapons Station), approximately 10 miles from the Air Base and 15 miles from downtown Charleston, is in the town of Goose Creek in Berkeley County. Both are located in the heart of the Lowcountry, the portion of historic South Carolina where pine and oak forests meet with the natural beauty of Intercoastal Waterway marshes and gorgeous barrier island beaches. With a rich military history and a moderate cost of living, the area has attracted many military retirees that now call the Lowcountry home. The Navy has several Commands in Charleston, as does the Coast Guard. The greater metropolitan region has a population of over 700,000 and we enjoy a great relationship with civilian communities where we actively participate in many civic, social and cultural events. ARRIVING AT JOINT BASE CHARLESTON

FLYING

• Charleston International Airport services the tri-county area and is in close proximity. In fact, the Air Base and the airport share runways. There are no military shuttles or mass transit that run from the airport to the base. Rental cars are available on- site. Commercial transportation is available from the airport to the base via taxi. Please ensure the taxi you take has access into the base, otherwise you will be dropped off at the gate. Yellow Cab taxi service is available from the airport to Joint Base Charleston (Air Base). Yellow Cab taxi is the only taxi service authorized to pick people up from off base and drop them off at their final destination on base. The number for Yellow Cab is (843) 577-6565. For any to save your receipt for reimbursement when you report in.

DRIVING TO THE AIR BASE

- From Charleston International Airport
 - Take the access road to Michaux Parkway and turn right. Proceed to Dorchester Road at intersection (light), turn right onto Dorchester Road. The Main Gate is approximately 1.5 miles on the right on Dorchester Road.
- From I-95 take, I-26 East to Ashley Phosphate Road, exit 209 A. Turn right onto Ashley Phosphate Road then turn left onto Cross County Road (go 2.2 miles). Then turn left onto Dorchester Road (go 0.8 mi) and make a left on W Hill Blvd.

DRIVING TO THE WEAPONS STATION

- From Charleston International Airport
 - Exit airport and head for I-526 east (also known as the Mark Clark Expressway). Exit I-526 at North Rhett (Exit 19) and turn left onto North Rhett. At the first light, turn right onto Remount Road. At the flashing red stop light, the gate to the JB Charleston-WS, South Annex will be on your left.
- From Points South or North
 - o Exit I-95 to I-26 east. Follow the directions listed below.
- From Points West
 - Exit I-26 to Hwy. 78 (exit 205). Travel east for 2 miles, staying left at the fork and traveling another 2 miles, through a traffic light. After a few yards on the overpass, turn right at the Hwy 52 West/Goose Creek exit. Travel Hwy 52 (Rivers Ave) for 1.5 miles and at the first light turn right onto Redbank Road base is 3 miles ahead.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

REPORTING PROCEDURES AT THE AIR BASE

- Joint Base Charleston base introduction information can be provided at either base gate or at the
 base lodging office. This information covers key facilities and phone numbers a newcomer should
 find helpful. The Inns of Charleston (lodging), located at 214 Arthur Drive, is the 24-hour arrival
 point. Those arriving after normal duty hours, on a holiday, or weekend should report there to sign
 in.
- Newcomers arriving on weekdays between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. must report to their units prior to reporting to the Military Personnel Section Customer Support Section (Building 503, Room 112) for in-processing on the day of arrival. The following documents are required for in-processing at the MPS CSS: your in-processing package (large sealed envelope), your in-processing worksheet (from gaining unit), Air Force Form 330 and a copy of your orders. The Commander's Support Staff in your gaining unit will schedule you for the next [mandatory] Newcomer Orientation workshop (held on the 3rd Thursday of each month). Newcomers arriving after normal duty hours, on a holiday, weekend or after 3:30 p.m. each business day, must turn in their in-processing package at the MPS CSS on the next duty day after arrival and after visiting their gaining unit. Your sponsor or unit designee will assist you with completing required paperwork related to in-processing.
- As mentioned previously, Newcomer Orientation briefings are held on the third Thursday of each month. The Commander's Support Staff in your gaining unit will assist with scheduling your attendance and coordinate with the Military & Family Readiness Center. Newcomer Orientation consolidates your mandatory briefings in one workshop.
- Your sponsor will be a big help in pointing you in the right direction or taking you to key locations until you are settled into your new community.
- If authorized, request approval for permissive temporary duty travel for house hunting with your unit's LeaveWeb point of contact. Your AF Form 988 will be filled out at this time; however, it must be approved by your gaining unit commander prior to beginning leave. Your gaining unit can grant up to eight days.
- You must in-process at the MPS Customer Support Section prior to taking permissive or ordinary leave.

REPORTING PROCEDURES AT THE WEAPONS STATION

• Please contact your gaining command to make arrangement for a sponsor to meet you for checking in during and after working hours. Naval Support Activity Charleston's Quarterdeck is not manned 24/7. If you are unsure of where you should "check in" for your new command at Naval Weapons Station, Joint Base Charleston, call the Base Quarterdeck for directions and guidance as to proper check-in procedures. They can be reached 24 hours a day by calling 843-794-7565/7642/4462 or DSN 312-794-7565/7642/4462. If reporting to a tenant command, please refer to the Major Units Listing tab for their contact information to learn of their procedures.

- If authorized, request approval for permissive leave for house hunting while in-processing. Your request will be filled out at this time; however it must be approved by your gaining command prior to beginning leave. Your gaining unit can grant up to eight days.
- Your sponsor will be a big help in pointing you in the right direction or taking you to key locations
 until you are settled into your new community. Review the article regarding Sponsorship and how
 you can request one assigned to you.

DOCUMENTS TO CARRY

• Important papers should not be packed with your household goods or hold baggage. Plan to take the following items with you: identification cards, PCS orders, passports, leave authorizations, shot records for you and your family, medical records, all documents pertaining to the shipment of household goods including your personal inventory and/or pictures of your possessions, appraisals for valuable items, last Leave and Earnings Statement, Power of Attorney (check expiration date), wills, bank books, state and federal tax records, deeds and mortgages, professional licenses, car registration, spouse resume and last pay statement, list of stocks and bonds, Social Security cards, school records for children, letters of credit for utility waivers, original birth and adoption records and naturalization records. Keep your sponsor, Key Spouse (Air Force personnel), quarterdeck (Navy personnel), and Command Ombudsman (Navy personnel) phone numbers with you at all times. Communicate freely and as needed.

TRAVEL PLANNING

- It is in your best interest to make temporary lodging arrangements as soon as possible.
 Temporary lodging at Foster Creek Villas, Naval Weapons Station, has only one pet friendly villa.
 Reservations can be made by calling 843-794-2120. Make kennel arrangements for pets if you will be staying in the military lodging system or hotels or motels that are not pet friendly.
 Lodging on the air base is available at the Inns of Charleston.
- There are two pet-friendly temporary lodging facilities available for an additional \$10 fee.
 Reservations can be made in advance by calling 843-963-8000 or DSN 312-673-8000. If on-base lodging is not available, lodging can provide a non-availability letter and list of off-base hotels. If needed, please remember your sponsor can and should assist with making your lodging reservations.

- Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH)
 - The Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) is a U.S. based allowance prescribed by geographic duty location, pay grade, and dependency status. It provides uniformed Service members equitable housing compensation based on housing costs in local civilian housing markets within the United States when government quarters are not provided. A uniformed service member stationed outside the U.S., including U.S. territories and possessions, not furnished government housing, is eligible for Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA).
 - For a complete listing of BAH rates, see BAH Rates for All Locations. Service members can calculate their individual BAH rates using the <u>BAH Calculator</u>. Beginning with the 2012 BAH rates, the Department is publishing the average percentage breakdown between rent and utilities for each Military Housing Area. This additional information will assist Service members with making informed housing choices when relocating to a new area.

VETERINARY CLINIC

- The Joint Base Charleston Veterinary Treatment Facility provides animal care as a service to active duty
 military, their dependents, and eligible retirees. The mission of the clinic is to provide protection for our
 troops and animals from infectious diseases, including those passed from animals to humans. To achieve
 this mission, the clinic offers vaccinations, heartworm prevention, flea control products, microchip
 implants and will treat infectious diseases to pet owners of active-duty personnel.
- The clinic also offers minor surgeries when staffing and scheduling permits. There are fees for these
 services. Another service is health certificates for Permanent Change of Station (PCS). To schedule
 appointments, register pets, and ask questions, you may send an email to CharlestonVTF@gmail.com;
 please provide service member's name, pet's name, and a good contact phone number in the email
 correspondence.
- While the veterinary clinic is dedicated to the care of all personally-owned animals, this service is not the main mission of the veterinarian. Doctors commissioned in the Army Veterinary Corps staff military veterinary clinics. 


